What we have been up to this week:

We are all back in school this week and raring to go. We have been having our termly pupil progress meetings with the teachers looking at how well the children are progressing and what we can put in place to support those children who are not making expected progress or who have a particular 'gap' in their learning.

If your child is one we have identified as not making expected progress s/he may be invited to join our Lexia and/or Athletics club before school. You may be asked to give some additional support at home by your child's teacher, or another strategy may be implemented in school.

If we have any concerns with regard to your child's progress or attainment your child's class teacher will be in touch. We have these meetings regularly to make sure we are able to identify any concerns quickly and put strategies in place to address them.

If you do not hear from school, but have any concerns about your child's progress do not hesitate to contact your child's teacher to discuss your worries. Remember we are always available in the playground at the start of the school day to talk to or to arrange a meeting. If not, contact the school office and Mrs Paver or Miss Batty will organise a meeting or phone call for you at a mutually convenient time.

The teachers all know the children really well and work hard to ensure that they are all on track and making good progress throughout the year. I'd like to take this opportunity to thank them for their hard work and commitment which has been evident in all our meetings.

Poor attendance has been one of the reasons for children missing out on teaching and learning opportunities and therefore slowing their progress. 97% is the expected level of attendance for every child and we ask everyone to try their best to meet this target to ensure their child is able to make good progress across the year. Thank you for your support in helping your child to achieve their full potential at school.
