Attendance: Congratulations to class 4 who had 99.2% attendance this week - you were our attendance stars. Well Done to you all!

What we have been up to this week:

This week has been filled with hard work and concentration as the Year 3,4 and 5 children and staff recover from the excitement of their concert and settle back into the routine of a normal school day.

Year 2 children are underway with their SATs assessments. They will be undertaking assessment papers in reading and mathematics to support teachers in making judgement on their reading, writing and mathematics against the national standard.

Year 6 have been in the throes of their final preparations for their SATs tests next week. They undertake tests in reading, mathematics, and spelling, punctuation and grammar. Unlike Year 2 SATs these are sent away to be marked and the outcomes are reported back to school in July. Teachers have to make a judgement on the children's writing against a set criteria. All this information is then used to set targets for the children's individual attainment and progress as they move to high school; and to support judgements of the effectiveness of the school's teaching.

Assessment week in school is for when the Year 3, 4 and 5 children undertake their in-school tests. These help teachers in making their final judgement about how the children are attaining in line with national expectations (age related expectations) and to get the children used to test conditions.

Whilst we try to minimise the stress and keep these tests and assessments as routine as possible they are all very important and we ask that you support your child and school in making sure the children are here and ready to undertake assessments in a positive frame of mind.

Fortunately our teachers plan lots of fun events and learning activities to ensure our school never loses the balance of a broad and balanced curriculum. **Ms Talbot**
