What we have been up to this week:-

We may be getting nearer to the end of term, but there has been no let up in the hard work going on in school. This week the children in Year 4 (Classes 7 and 8) undertook their Times Tables Check. This will be statutory for all schools from next year. Fortunately our children are used to Times Tables Rock Stars and are therefore building up their speed and knowledge of their times tables on a regular basis. We will let you know how your child has done through Tapestry once the results are released.

Times tables are an essential part of building children's maths skills, just as phonics are an essential part of learning to read. It is no surprise then that there is a move to check these vital skills at key points in your child's time in school.

Some of our talented artists went out on a special art trip to the Hepworth Gallery on Wednesday to look at and find out about the art works held there and then to work with a local artist. They had a fantastic day and came back full of enthusiasm to further develop their art skills.

We have long had a tradition of developing our children's sporting abilities and have an established range of opportunities to develop these skills through events and tournaments, so this year we have started to try and develop the same level of opportunities for children in school with other abilities. Our school council have been very proactive and involved in a number of community projects; we have introduced the Prince William Trust Award to support children in building resilience and team work skills; and also the art projects. Next year we hope to build and extend on these to offer as many children as possible the opportunity to develop as individuals and to hone particular talents whilst they are at our school.

Teachers have all been working on the children's end of year reports and these will be available to download from next Friday. We keep the accounts open for those children leaving next Friday to transfer to Rodillian so that you can still access them until the start of the new school year in September. You will get a notification as soon as they are available.
