Year 6—Applying for a High School Place

The application process for secondary school year 7 places starting in September 2020 is open and a link to the on-line application process can be found on Leeds City Council website: https://www.leeds.gov.uk/residents/children-families-and-carers/schools-and-learning/school-places/ admissions-secondary-schools. Please note that the closing date is on 31st October 2019. It is important that you submit your application before this date.

Because your child attends our school they will have priority for a place at Woodkirk Academy, therefore please ensure that you include this as one of your choices.

After you have applied on line you will receive a confirmation email stating that your preferences have been received (please keep this e-mail). It can take up to 24 hours to receive your confirmation e-mail.

NB: If you do not receive an acknowledgement email within 24 hours your application has not been completed successfully; you should go back and make sure it is completed properly.

Offers of school places will be sent out on 2nd March.

The Admissions Team have arranged drop-in sessions to help Year 6 families with the application process and answer questions at several venues across the city this year, alternatively families can contact the Admissions Team on 0113 222 4414.
