#### What we have been up to this week:

First week back after the holidays and we are already in fullswing and getting all the children on board and loving their new topics.

The football team are straight back into action and playing their next round of matches. We are missing Mrs Fletcher and everything she brought to PE at our school, but we are making sure that we keep PE and sports on the boil and high profile just as they have always been.

To that end, we are having our 'Wake Up Shake Up' competition at the end of the half-term. Every class makes up a keep-fit routine to a piece of music which they then perform in front of the other classes for our panel of judges.

The children have all been choosing the track they are going to use and making up their routines this week. They will then practise and refine them until they all know exactly what they are doing and keep in sync. Every class produces a routine to a really high standard and they are a joy to watch. We will post them all on Tapestry when they are ready.

Lots of our Year 4 children made up a Skipping Team this week to enter the annual competition. They were complimented on their excellent behaviour, their support for one another and, of course, for winning lots of events. Our thanks to the Year 4 staff who have been training them up and getting them match ready. You clearly did a great job.

This half-term is very busy as we have lots of the end of year statutory assessments going on. Year 6 have their SATs in the week beginning 13th May 2024. They have written tests in Reading, Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar (Spag), and Mathematics that are sat in test conditions and sent away to be marked externally. Their Writing is assessed internally and teacher judgements submitted.

Year 2 have assessments throughout the month of May to enable teachers to make judgements on whether they are meeting age related expectations in Reading, Writing and Mathematics. These judgements are shared nationally.

Next half-term our Year 4 children will be undertaking the Multiplications Tables Check (MTC) and our Year 1 children will be undertaking the Phonics screening check.

Whilst the children are all working hard and focussed on showing their best in all the assessments, there is still plenty of fun learning going on. Never a dull moment in our school!




#### **KS1 and KS2 Movie Nights:**

YouTube gives users the option of upleading videos as "private" or "unlisted" — so they could be shared exclusively with family and Friends, for example. Comments on videos can also be disabled and channels that your child is subscribed to can be hidden. If your child is only upleading videos that are protected as 'private', they are for less likely to receive direct messages from strongers.


